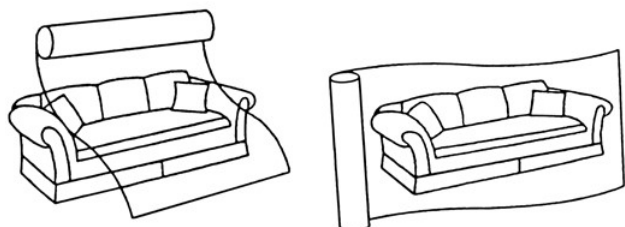

Upholstery fabric use grade

Grades Description of intended duty

OD	Occasional domestic use, i.e. fabrics which are traditionally used for their aesthetic appeal but will not meet all the standards required for careful domestic use
LD	Light domestic use, i.e. occasional or light wear, use for simple styles of furniture. Unsuitable for furniture with upholstered arms, self piping or buttoning
GD	General domestic
SD	Severe domestic or general contract
GC	General contract
SC	Severe contract

The Furniture and Furnishing (Fire) (Safety) Regulations 1988

The following are the codes relevant to G P & J Baker fabrics that are used in the list and will appear on our advice notes and invoices:

B	Resistant to smouldering cigarette tested over standard foam plus 2.0 oz polyester wrap
H	Match resistant (FR1)
K	Must not be used for domestic upholstery on furniture made after 31st December, 1949
M	Exempt fabric must be used with a schedule 3 interliner (EXEMPT)
Z	Not to be used for domestic upholstery
5	Resistant to ignition source 5 = wooden crib tested over CHMR foam
Z*	Fabric meets furniture and furnishings regulations when backcoated.

Tested according to BS 5852 Part 1 as modified in the Regulations.

BH	Resistant to smouldering cigarette tested over standard foam plus 2.0 oz polyester wrap. B.I.T.A. Flamcode B. Match resistant. B.I.T.A. Flamcode H this symbol appears on pattern books, samples and cuttings
BM	Indicates an upholstery or multi purpose fabric which is Exempt under the Fire Regulations and must be used for upholstery only with a schedule 3 barrier.
